


# USE THIS GUIDE

We thank you for merchants who give us access to your bounty.


We thank you for the hands that make and prepare our daily bread.


Give us nourishment to do your work in the world so that, fed, we can feed others. May our work and faith in you create that heavenly community where all are fed.

# TRACK YOUR FUNDRAISING ONLINE






# "GLOBAL FARM CHALLENGE: MORE THAN FOOD"

# GLOBAL FARM CHALLENGE DO-IT-YOURSELF FIELD EXPERIENCE


This guide will help you set up your own Global Farm Challenge Field Experience, an opportunity for youth and adults to experience the challenges smallholder farmers face bringing their crops to market as they aim to produce enough profit for food and savings. Each participant will follow one of four "stories" through one growing season as a smallholder farmer. Participants will be confronted with obstacles representing real challenges for farmers and learn how relatively simple interventions can make big changes for farming communities.





### Be the first to fill your field in this fast-paced card game!



You'll need some solid strategy to raise enough crops for the market while dealing with the unexpected during your growing season, but trading for tools, forming alliances and a bit of luck will help! Players will have fun learning about some of the challenges and opportunities farmers face around the world.



Each deck contains Soil cards to start your field, Supply cards to help transform your soil into seedlings and Chance cards that can change the game in a single turn.
Full instructions are also included, as well as profiles drawn from the real projects supported by ELCA World Hunger that the game is based on. If you play it on the road or at home, the Global Farm Challenge podcast series offers deeper dives into the projects behind the game.

# FEATURED FUNDRAISING GOAL: **FUND A FAMILY FARM**

Talk about transformation! A cow, a couple goats, a dozen chicks, two pigs, farming tools, seeds, and agricultural training and support can help a family achieve a fresh start. Challenge your group to raise \$715 to provide a family with new tools and techniques so crops can grow stronger than ever. Eggs, milk and meat from the farm animals provide a lifetime of food to eat and sell at the market, helping a family escape the cycle of hunger and poverty — for good.




# ADVOCACY

#### WHAT IS THE FARM BILL?

The farm bill is legislation passed every five years that has a tremendous impact on hunger in the United States and globally. The current farm bill expires in 2023, so the process where the programs covered in the bill are debated, refreshed and ultimately passed by Congress toward being signed into law is ramping up. Now is the time for our input and advocacy to shape the next farm bill.

#### WHY DOES THE FARM BILL MATTER?

Priorities in your community and globally, such as healthy food access for low-income families, reducing food waste, conservation practices, rural development and much more, connect in this policy. The ELCA supports a farm bill that will promote a strong and resilient food-supply chain and provide needed nutrition through domestic and international programs. Our advocacy as Lutherans in this process will draw attention to faith-based priorities to end hunger and create a more sustainable world as they play out in our lives and the lives of our neighbors through this policy.






# DIFFERENCE!


### MORE RESOURCES FOR YOUTH




# DIGGING IN: A LEADER'S GUIDE TO SERVICE LEARNING


### WALK FOR WATER DO-IT-YOURSELF TRACK EXPERIENCE


ELCA World Hunger's Walk for Water is an opportunity for youth and adults to experience firsthand what it is like to carry a 5-gallon jug of water (41.5 pounds) through a simulated water collection experience. Throughout the simulation, each person follows one of five "stories" to guide them along the track. Along the way, participants are confronted with different obstacles that help them realize some of the struggles those walking for water may encounter.

This guide is intended to help you set up your own Walk for Water experience. The setup is based on how ELCA World Hunger designed the track at the ELCA Youth Gathering in 2015, but you are encouraged to be creative in your context.

# PLANT A COMMUNITY GARDEN


