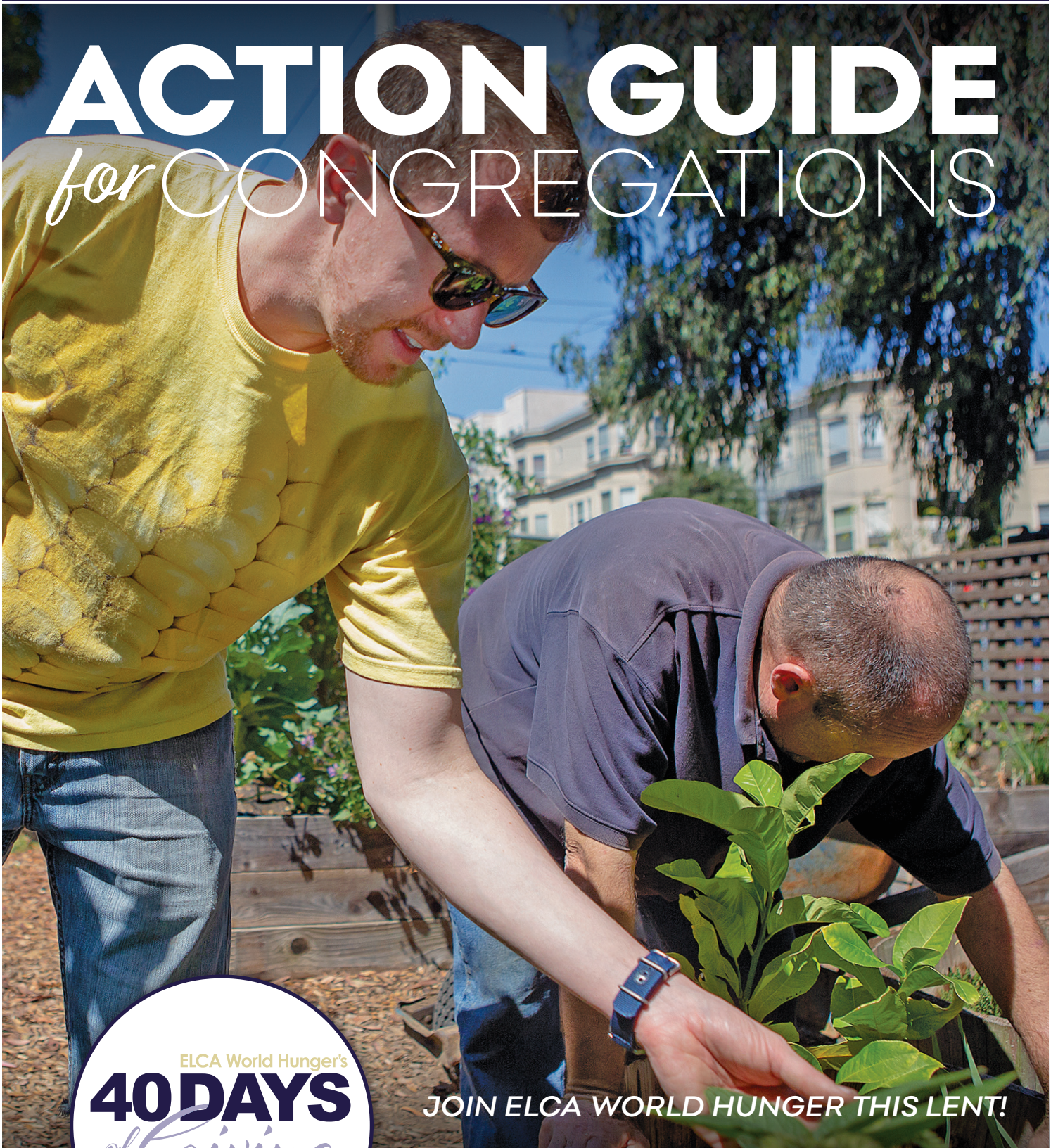

This Lent, you're invited to join together with fellow supporters to study, pray and give during ELCA World Hunger's 40 Days of Giving. Experience how the grace of Christ moves us to engage in transformative works of love around the world through ELCA World Hunger as God calls us into the ministry of hope, liberation and restoration for our world.

Lent is a time of reflection and repentance, of sacrifice and self-examination. But Lent is also a season of hope — hope in the work God is doing in the world, even in the most challenging times. This Lent, join ELCA World Hunger as we journey with our neighbors in hope for a just world where all are fed. Bring ELCA World Hunger into your congregation and worshipers' homes with resources that include:



- 1) A devotional calendar with daily ideas for reflection and action,
- 2) A weekly study with inspirational stories and information about how your gifts to ELCA World Hunger are at work in the world, and
- 3) Additional resources, including coin jar wrappers and an inspirational weekly email series, to invite children and families into the practice of giving to the church to end hunger and poverty.

Let your steadfast love, O Lord, be upon us, even as we hope in you.

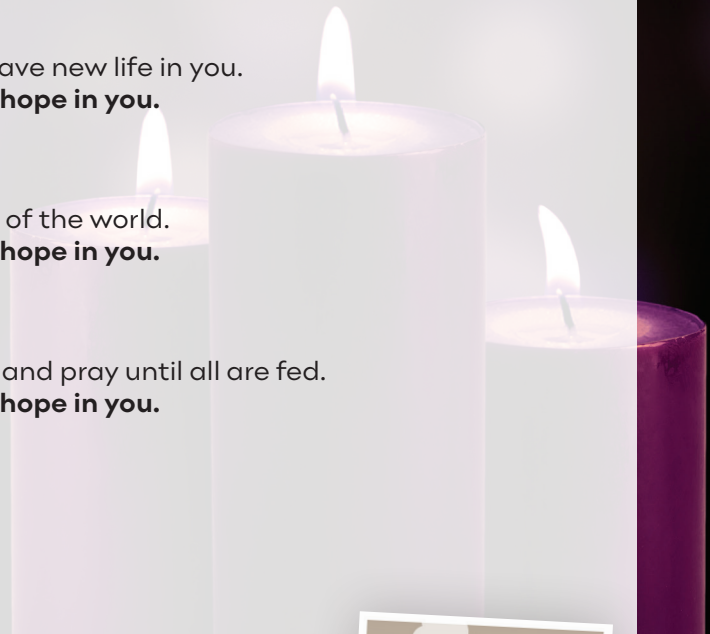
The Samaritan woman said to Jesus,

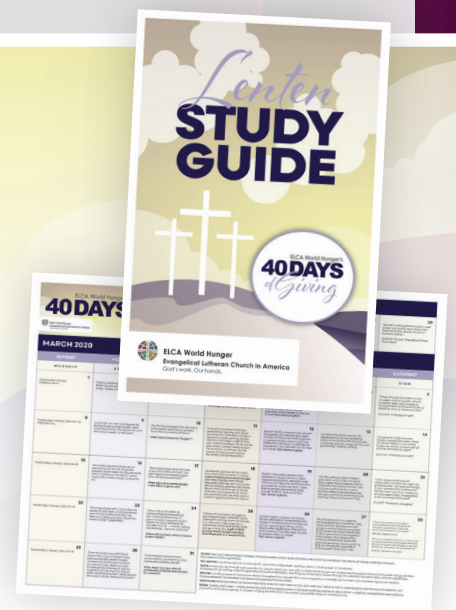


LENTEN STUDY GUIDE

GET READY FOR VALENTINE'S DAY

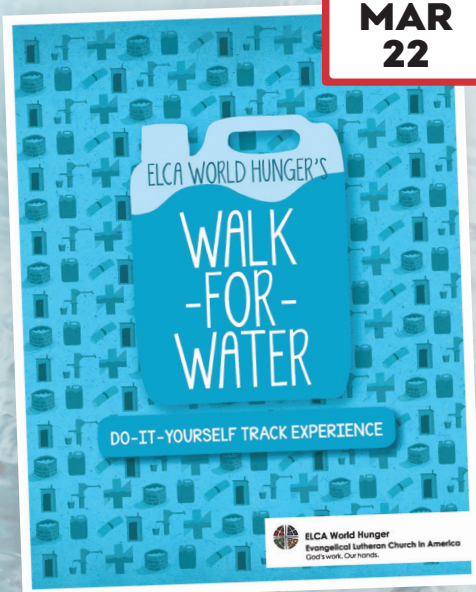

WORLD WATER DAY



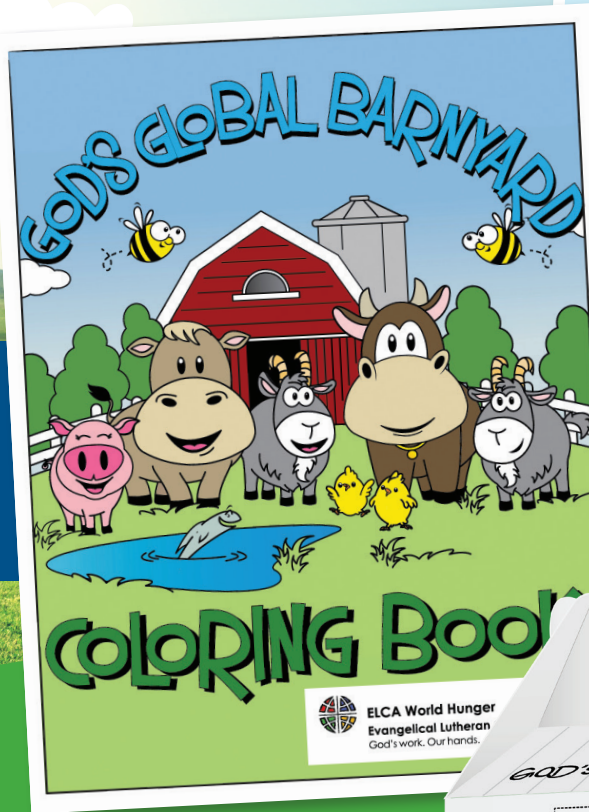
For World Water Day 2020, bring the ELCA World Hunger Walk for Water experience to your congregation. The do-it-yourself program gives you step-by-step instructions on how your group can experience what it's like to carry a five-gallon jug of water (41.5 pounds) through a simulated water collection experience. Throughout the simulation, each person follows one of five "stories" to guide them along the track. Along the way, participants will confront different obstacles that help them realize some of the struggles those walking for water may encounter.

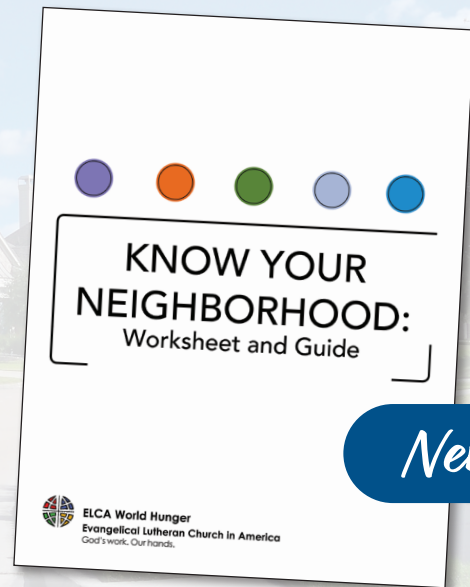

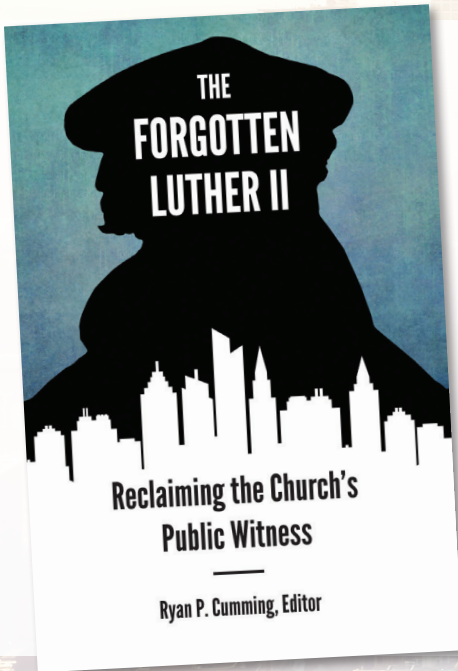

"THE FORGOTTEN LUTHER II"



In the book "The Forgotten Luther II: Reclaiming the Church's Public Witness," Lutheran scholars argue for a cogent, clear, biblically based and theologically grounded rationale for how the church speaks and acts in the political arena. This book looks carefully at the public witness of Martin Luther and its meaning for preaching, teaching and carrying out public ministry today. Luther's conviction was that government is responsible to God for containing evil and maintaining good order, and for ensuring that no person lives in hunger or want.

The book asks critical questions: When should the church support the state's agenda? When should it resist? What are the options for critical but constructive cooperation?

"The Forgotten Luther II" comes with discussion questions to guide reflection, and video interviews with the authors are available online.
